- Currently, desk officer in Federal Ministry of the Interior and Community, Department for Cyber and Information Security

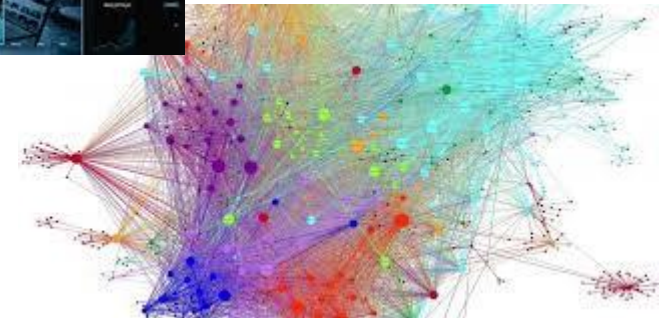
# Why am I here?
